

ALICE 5.0 – a docufiction-film

Germany 2011 / 45 minutes / 16:9 full HD Topics: Business models of social media, Google and Facebook, web 2.0, Second Life, credit scoring, online identity

Prometheus, a dropout, lives in a humble tree house. His real home is a mighty Social Network called Host, though. It provides the possibility to connect to other humans, even though Prometheus is living in the complete wilderness.

Surprisingly he is being struck by a fatal error message, which threatens his entire existence: Losing his Host profile wouldn't only cause his digital, but also his social death.

The movie "Alice 5.0" traces the deletion of a user who doesn't fit the pattern of the big corporations. Scientists and businessmen accompany Prometheus' digital dying with their statements and turn this movie into an exciting piece of research. Is the error message a virus? Or is it connected with the notorious user scoring, a program used by Host itself? And, not least, how does the corporation achieve its gigantic business volume?

In deed they *do* talk about the very presence – almost all of them are real, as the viewer learns later on.

"Alice 5.0" takes the liberty of not marking the exact border between documentary and fiction. The plot is presented in an exaggerated manner, which satirizes a genre we all know from television, the documentary TV film.

Moreover, the film combines topics that are only connected loosely in the real world. It analyzes existing technologies and business models and synthesizes them in one company: the *Host*. Some characters, for instance the spokesman of *Google* Germany, represent this fictitious Social Network in the film. Others, like the spokesman of *Creditreform*, advert to techniques as credit scoring and to further marketing strategies of *Host*.

By the end of the movie the viewer does not know the real identities of these characters. This provides the possibility to interpret their statements freely. It is not until the end titles that the exact construction of the film is revealed to the viewer, who now has to admit that all elements used to construct this futuristic illusion are already part of our present reality.
